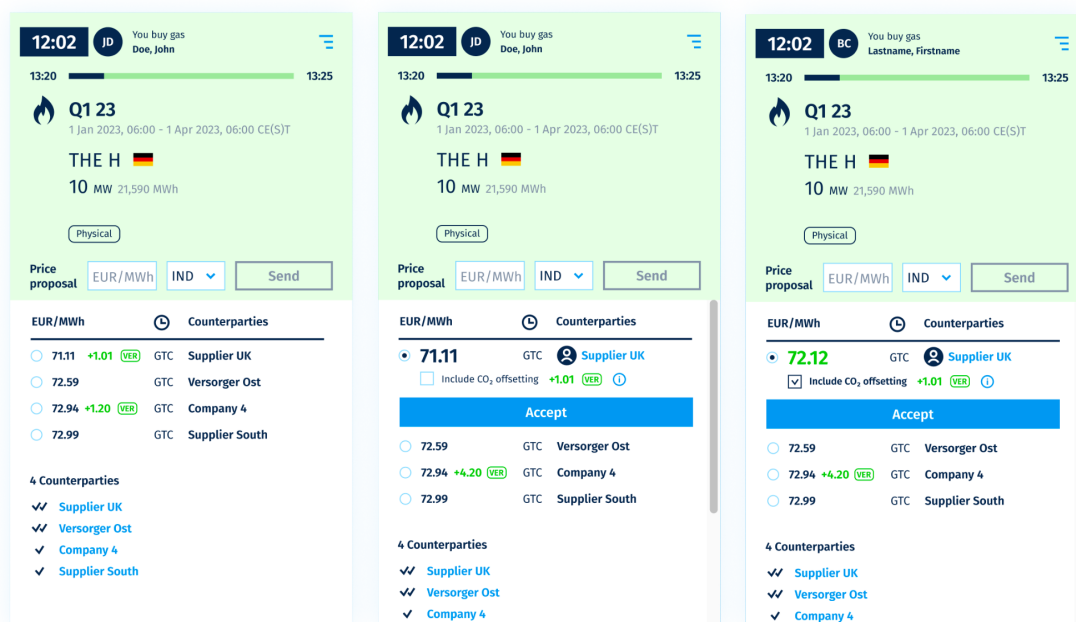


# Carbon compensated gas (CCG) on enmacc

## Overview

For the first time, voluntary emission reduction (VER) certificates can be added to trades of natural gas. As part of this feature, enmacc automatically calculates the amount of certificates to offset the combustion<sup>1</sup> of gas being traded.



## Participating suppliers

RWE is an initial supplier of VERs, with more joining in the future. Further information about this offering is available in the enmacc contract center. *VER standards: VCS and Gold Standard, any vintage 2016 or younger*

## **How to benefit**

Demand side:

RFQs for buying gas will include the option of VERs if quoted by a qualifying supplier. Buyers initiating an RFQ can simply add the VER certificates to their gas order.

Supply side:

Gas suppliers, once qualified, can quote VERs alongside their gas price.

## **Trading fee & billing**

Following a successful trade of VERs, enmacc will charge both parties a fee based on the tCO<sub>2</sub>e traded. This is billed in the normal billing cycle, together with the gas trade.
